Age limit for JRF is 28 years & PA (level - II) is 32 years as on the date of advertisement which is relaxed upto 5 years for candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC, Women and Physically Handicapped candidates.

General Conditions:-

- 1. Leave and other entitlement benefits:-** The JRF are eligible only for casual leave & Project Assistant will be entitled for 12 days leave (1 day per completed month). Maternity leave as per Govt. of India instructions issued from time to time would be available to female candidates in all categories.

2. Participation of JRF in any scientific event/workshops in India or abroad will be treated as on duty". The travel entitlement for JRF for participation in scientific events/workshops in India will be 2nd AC by rail.
3. **Publication/Patent:** the results of JRF research work may be published in standard refereed journals at the discretion of the Director, CSIR-CRRI. It should be ensured by the fellow that the assistance provided by the funding agency of Govt. of India is acknowledged in all such publications.
4. **Obligations of JRF:**
 - a. He/ She shall be governed by the disciplinary regulations of the host Institute where he/she is working.
 - b. The JRF must send a detailed consolidated report of the research work done during the entire period of their tenure at the earliest.
5. HRA as per rule may be allowed for JRF in accordance with DST Guidelines.
6. Based on performance after two years the JRF may be awarded/upgraded to SRF as per DST guidelines.

Mode of Selection: In case large number of candidates turn up, the candidates will be shortlisted prior to interview by the Selection Committee.

Mere fulfilling the essential qualification doesn't guarantee his/her selection. The decision of Selection Committee shall be final and no query shall be entertained in this regard.

Eligible candidates may appear for "Floating (Walk-in) Interview" on the date mentioned above between **09.00 A.M to 10.00 A.M** (candidate will not be entertained after **10.00 A.M** under any circumstance) in the Auditorium of the Institute with all original and self-attested copies of all certificate/testimonials and identity proof (Voters Card, Pan card., Driving Licence ,Passport etc) and **one passport size photograph**. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/PH should bring copies of certificate in the proper format issued by the appropriate authority as per the latest instructions issued from time to time on the subject. The candidates are encouraged to talk in Hindi during interview.

No TA/DA will be paid to the candidates for appearing in the interview.
